Jotdeep Singh heads the Renewable Energy and Carbon Credits unit of Rabobank in India. He has been involved with financing wind energy and other renewable energy projects for over 3 years. His other experience includes structured finance, turnaround finance and advisory, corporate term lending, and leveraged finance. Prior to joining Rabobank, Jotdeep Singh has worked at ANZ and Citibank in San Jose on California. Rabo India has been financing wind power for over 5 years, and is deeply committed to the industry.
